Pick-up, Village Hall and traffic

I am aware that parking at home time has presented a few problems and we're hoping that, with clubs starting next week, it will alleviate some of the issues. I have asked all staff to park on the school car park as well. It would be worth considering car/lift-sharing - not only would this reduce congestion but also reduce fuel consumption and a be a super tick in our "eco box."

Can I also remind you of the one-way system that we have in place for dropping off and picking up. Please approach the Village Hall car park by driving up towards school (from the direction of Martins Moss or around the triangle behind the Village Hall) and turning left into the car park. Please then leave by turning left out of the village hall. If you approach school for drop-off or pick-up from the direction of Church, and are turning right into the village hall, you will have difficulty against the flow of traffic that are following the one-way system. However, please bear in mind that we don't expect members of the local community to know about this arrangement so you will occasionally meet some on-coming traffic. If you're not sure, please ask.
