



Plants

Vocabulary	
Seed	The small parts produced by plants from which new plants grow.
Roots	These anchor the plant into the ground and absorb nutrients from the soil.
Temperature	How warm or cold something or somewhere is. Some plants like it cooler and some like it warmer.
Sunlight	Light from the sun that helps plants to grow
Deciduous	Trees that shed their leaves once a year, usually during the season of autumn, when their leaves are mature, or fully grown
Evergreen	Evergreen plants are plants that never lose their leaves - they "stay green" all year long
Germination	When a tiny new plant bursts out of its shell after soaking up water.
Nutrients	Food or nourishment for the plant. They get this from the soil.
Seed dispersal	When the seeds move away from the parent plant. They can drop to the ground or be moved by the wind or animals.
